



Kimberly Kent Art Brokerage is accepting submissions for 2D art, paintings, prints, or groupings of small works.

Patton Home was built in 1890 with money raised by 29 women, on land donated by a pioneer who herded sheep along the Oregon Trail. It was managed for over a century by the Ladies Union Relief Society of the Methodist Church. Mathew Patton, the original owner of Patton Home, donated the property to the women with a stipulation that they use the building to provide food, shelter, and friendship to those in need. Today, Patton Home continues a tradition of serving people in need. The 120-year-old residential facility offers home-style accommodations for 63 residents.

KKAB is thrilled to work with this team to create an art package that will weave together the diversity and local history of the local community. Diverse artists and individuals with unique perspectives are encouraged to submit. Artists may submit existing artwork **or** a proposal for custom work for a wall covering, weaving, 2D art, installation piece, or other wall art concept.

Artwork will be selected based on the art selection team's preference for work that is:

- Warm and welcoming
- Reflective of the culture and history of Patton Home and it's diverse population
- Complimentary to the interior design concepts
- **Bonus:** artist or artists team is based in the NE Portland area

Submission Inclusions –

- Resume **or** artist statement **or** tell us a little about yourself.
- Contact information including address, email and phone number. Please include website if you have one.
- Image of the existing art, or a sketch and description of your idea/concept
- Detailed budget or cost for artwork
- Imagery Up to 10 JPEG images of previous and related work. All photos, paintings and other works of art must be original and the submitting artists must have all rights to the images.
- Images should be named:
 - o Last name size medium price
 - o Example: "Kent 24x36 watercolor 500."
